RESPONSIBILITIES

Affiliate

- All affiliates are to download the **Team** Nomination Form and email it to the correct host by the date advertised.
- All affiliates are to download the Referee
 Nomination Form and email it to the correct referee coordinator by the date advertised.
- All affiliates are to download the Team Sign-On Sheet and email it to the host affiliate 24hours before event with correct playing numbers of players
- All affiliates are required to request tent area with the host affiliate. Preference will be given to early nominations and early payments.

Coach/Manager

- All team officials must complete the online registration before they participate
- All Managers are to inform host affiliate of any changes to the **Team Sign-On Sheet** before a game is played.

Players

- All participants must complete online registration before they are to take the field
- Parent/Guardian Nominates Child online and agrees to TFA & SQBD Declarations

Parent / Gaurdian

- Parent/Guardian of participant must be present at the venue PENDING COVID POLICY
- Parent/Guardian must abide by all club & touch football codes of conduct.
- Parent/Guardian can not drink or smoke at the venue

Titans Membership

 Every participant registered from the South Queensland region in the 2021 Titans Junior Tri-Series will receive 2 tickets to a Titans game. (Titans Junior Membership)



Competition

Format

- A round robin format will be used for preliminary games.
- Where pools are required, cross over semi-finals will be played.
- Positions for the finals will be determined by:
- · Teams with the highest points at the completion of round
- If equal For and Against
- If equal Percentages
- If equal Result of round game
- If still equal Coin toss
- Points will be allocated as follows: 3 (win), 2 (draw), 1 (loss) & 0 (forfeit loss)
- All games will be played under the TFA 8th edition rules.
- One grade per division. (The SQBD Tri-Series is a preparation tournament for Junior State Cup. This allows for any Development teams to play against stronger teams before the Qld Junior State Cup in their relevant division).
- Affiliates may enter as many teams as needed to support affiliate

Prizes

Division Winners

• The winners in each division will be presented with medallions. (no runners up medal)

Club Championships

- Whilst teams outside SQBD & SWQ regions are allowed to participate. They are not eligible for club championships.
- Only one team per division can accumulate points to the club championship. This will go to the highest ranked team from the division
- Points will be allocated as follows: 5 (Grand Final), 3 (Runner Up), 1 (Semi Final)
- Perpetual Trophy (Jones/Piper) to be awarded to the winning affiliate.



The Fine Print

Team & Player Eligibility

- This event is for representative teams from TFA affiliated competitions only. It is the responsibility of each affiliate to ensure that their players and officials are registered and fully financial members of all affiliated bodies.
- To be eligible to participate, players must have played
 Five (5) games in any affiliated Season (2020) or Season
 1 (2021) competition with the affiliate they are
 representing at this tournament.
- No player is permitted to play in more than one team
- A player may apply in writing to SQBD 7 days prior to the first event to participate for another affiliate, (with club approval), provided their home affiliate does not supply a team in their age group or they trialed and were not selected.
- Any affiliate outside SQBD is considered a Guest Affiliate. Guest Affiliates are permitted subject to draw.
 SWQ and SQBD affiliate teams have preference to draw provided the team is nominated on or before the closing date of nominations.
- To be eligible to participate in the finals series, players must have participated in at least two (2) round games at the host event.

Minimum Age & Divisions

10s Divisions

 Teams may only register and use a maximum of 12 players in a game.

12, 14, 16 & 18s Divisions

- Teams may only register and use 14 players per Leg
- Any team found guilty of either using more than the stipulated number of players or using an unregistered player may be disqualified from the event.
 - Under 18 Boys & Girls Born on or after 01/01/2003
 - Under 16 Boys & Girls Born on or after 01/01/2005
 - Under 14 Boys & Girls Born on or after 01/01/2007
 - Under 12 Boys & Girls Born on or after 01/01/2009
 - Under 10 Boys & Girls Born on or after 01/01/2011

Duty Referee

- All Teams MUST supply 1 referee per team for the competition with their nomination, minimum Level 1 for U10 - U14 and Minimum Level 2 for U16 - U18
- · All Referees are paid,
- \$15.00 per solo for L1 L2
- \$20.00 per solo for L3 L6
- · All referees \$10.00 per dual
- Grand Finals are paid \$10 per Triple. Referees are paid in cash at the end of each day.
- All delegates will be contacted by the Host Referee Coordinator

Forfeits

- Teams must be in attendance at their playing fields five
 (5) minutes before the commencement of their match to complete the coin toss..
- · Any team that forfeits will not be eligible for finals.
- If a team is late, one point may be awarded to the opposition team for every minute up to and including 5 points. Referee will determine allocated time.
- If the offending team is not in attendance after the five (5) minutes has expired, the game will be deemed a forfeit and the non offending team will be awarded a 5/0 win and three (3) competition points.

Game Duration options

- 15 minute halves, with a 2 minute half time break.
- 12 minute haves with a 1 minute half time break.
- 25 minute straight, no half time, touchdown turnaround
- N.B. Each Affiliate will communicate this when draw is released.

Insurance

 All injuries must be reported on the day by Team Manager to Host Tournament Manager

Host affiliate reserves the right to determine and/or interpret matters not covered or specified by the Conditions of Entry and take appropriate action

The Fine Print

Forced Majeure

- If SQBD host affiliate is unable to perform, in whole or part in any obligation under these regulations of a Force Majeure Event, SQBD is relieved of that obligation under these regulations to the extent, and the period it is unable to perform.
- In addition to this, SQBD has no obligation to refund to any individual or team any fees paid if it is unable to perform by reason of a Force Majeure Event.
- FORCE MAJEURE EVENT: for the purposes of these regulations a force majeure event includes but is not limited to any or all of the following:
- Acts of God including flood, drought, earthquake, storm, cyclone, fire, explosion, epidemic; or
- War or Act of Terrorism; or
- · Riot or civil disturbances; or
- Permanent injunction of any duly constituted court of competent jurisdiction; or
- Any fact, circumstance, matter or thing beyond the reasonable control of SQBD / QTF / TFA.

Mutual Respect Policy

- Referees will be instructed to enforce zero tolerance rules regarding referee abuse from players, coaching staff and spectators.
- Teams/Players are bound by the Disciplinary Regulations Manual un-sportsman like behaviour eg sledging and or acting in an abusive manner towards the referee or opposing team.
- Teams/players/spectators that consume or introduce alcohol at the venue outside the laws associated with liquor license requirements will be asked to leave.

Medical

- Each association or team is responsible for the provision of medical assistance for their teams at the tournament.
- First Aid will be available from host affiliate for the treatment of minor injuries sustained at this tournament, not for strapping of injuries, pre-existing conditions or rub downs.
- Ambulance will be called for more serious injuries.

Protest

- Protests will be heard and determined by the Judiciary and or designated Protest Committee. The Competition Committee will form the Protest Committee. It will include at least three committee members or persons designated by the committee (2 hosts, 1 SQBD)
- Protests must be lodged in writing within twenty (20)
 minutes of the conclusion of the event in question, to
 the Competition Manager or to an official designated by
 the Competition Manager.
- The protest is to be lodged and signed by the Team Manager or their nominated representative.
- The protest will then be investigated by the Protest Committee. The Team Manager or their nominated representative will be notified of the decision.
- Any notice to be served on any person to attend a hearing will be served on the Team Manager or nominated representative of the team involved, and any such service is deemed to be served on all parties or persons under the control of that Team Manager or their nominated representative
- A cost for a protest is a \$200 deposit. If the protest is deemed successful the \$200 is refunded.

QLD TOUCH UNDER 10 RULES

- Teams play five (5) a side at any one time, max 12 in a team
- Field Size is 50m x 35m
- Acting Half can not run with the ball, they must pass off
- Defense can not move up until first receiver has touched the ball
